

Computer Matching Process for ED-TEP Concentration

Application Checklist:

 All items listed on the DICAS application checklist are required for the U of M DI Program, with the exception of Tests. GRE and TOEFL tests are not required for entrance to U of M Dietetic Internship.

□ Personal Statement

As part of the DICAS application, you will be asked to complete a personal statement in 1,200 words or less. Questions to be addressed in your personal statement include:

- O Why are you interested in the dietetics profession?
- o What experiences have helped prepare you for a career in dietetics?
- o What are your short-term and long-term goals?
- What are your strengths and weaknesses / areas needing improvement?

In addition, the following questions must be addressed in your personal statement when applying to our ED-TEP concentration:

- Why are you applying to the U of M DI and its eating disorders concentration?
- o What challenges do you anticipate encountering while in the U of M DI Program?
- o What are your top three reasons we should choose you over another candidate?

☐ *Three* **References** are required

- Two from professors/faculty members in the department where you complete(d) your DPD program and/or graduate work
- One from a work or volunteer supervisor, preferably one who is a practicing RD who has observed your skills for more than three months

Complete the ED-TEP Supplemental Application Form and upload to your DICAS
application as a Supplemental document.

- o A printed copy of your uploaded ED-TEP Supplemental Application Form
- A check or money order for the \$50 DI application fee (non-refundable) made payable to "University of Minnesota." Note: Your "processed" check will be verification that your supplemental application form & fee were received. A confirmation email will be sent if a money order is received as payment.
